





ANCIENT WONDERS MEET MODERN INNOVATION

Born in Cairo 47 years ago, Romani Munir Azmi moved to Italy in the 1990s. After graduating in materials engineering from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia in 2003, he took on the role of head of the technological laboratory at a well-known manufacturer of bulk material handling and processing systems in Sassuolo. He later worked as Quality Manager and Kaizen Team Leader of another Modena-based equipment manufacturer for the assembly department of Tetra Pak® packaging machines. In 2012, he joined the R&D department at WAMGROUP® before being appointed General Manager of WAM Egypt in 2016.

NL What about the situation in your country?

Azmi The market had been growing across various sectors, especially in concrete production, until early 2022, despite the impact of Covid. However, from then until March 2024, Egypt faced severe economic and political challenges due to the devaluation of the Egyptian pound, crippling markets further, worsened by the October 7th conflict between Palestine and Israel. Since March 2024, the pound's devaluation has stabilised, and the market is

slowly beginning to recover.

NL Anything particular about Egypt?

Azmi End users are increasingly sourcing their processing plants locally instead of importing them. This shift presents a clear advantage for WAM Egypt, positioning the company as a key supplier of plant components in the local market.

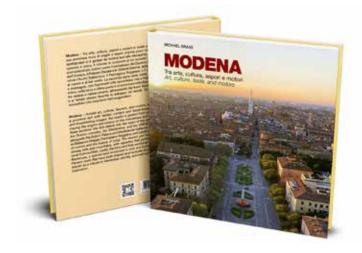

stablished in 2011, WAM

with the turbulence of the Arab
Spring and the ensuing Egyptian
uprising, which led to the collapse of
the government. The period of instability gripped the nation until 2013,
with significant economic fallout.

A new government was elected in 2014, bringing gradual political and economic stability. Markets began to reopen, but for WAM Egypt, the years from 2011 to 2015 were challenging.

Operating from a small sales office in a residential apartment, the company faced limited market share and recurring financial losses.

A turning point came in 2016 with a strategic move to a new facility in the 6^{th} of October City industrial zone. Backed by WAMGROUP®'s support and a revamped strategy focusing on stock availability — particularly for the construction sector — WAM Egypt steadily increased its market share. This momentum drove annual

revenue growth, nearly doubling each year, culminating in significant financial results by 2021. The original site had become too small, prompting a move in 2022 to a larger 2,300m² facility in the same industrial area.

With enhanced capacity and a 25% surge in turnover that year, WAM Egypt cemented its position as a formidable player in Egypt's construction and industrial sectors.
